Counseling and Guidance Program

The student development program in the district is a preventive guidance and counseling program for all students consistent with the Oregon Department of Education Child Development Program. Activities of this program are an integral part of the educational process.

Licensed or state authorized staff implement the district's guidance and counseling goals by providing a purposeful, continuous and coordinated program designed to assist students to:

1. Develop skills in interpersonal relations;
2. Accept increasing responsibility for their own actions;
3. Develop decision-making skills;
4. Obtain information about self;
5. Utilize school and community resources;
6. Understand the educational opportunities and alternatives available to them;
7. Establish tentative career and educational goals.

These goals will be accomplished through a variety of direct and indirect services to students including classroom guidance, small group activities, teacher and parent consultation and community outreach.
