Community Use of District Facilities

The district facilities represent the only non-private property in the Riverdale area, and as such, should be utilized as a key community resource. Such uses contribute to the betterment of the Riverdale community and as such should be promoted.

It is the policy of the district to make Riverdale facilities available for use by the community for activities that are a service to the residents of Riverdale, and that contribute to the educational, recreational and public service aspects of community life. These facilities shall be made available to community groups on request and approval of the superintendent, and the cost, if any, will be consistent with the District's Use of Facilities Fee schedule.

The following guidelines shall be utilized in making facilities available:

1. Times will not conflict with the regular school day or school related activities;
2. The superintendent may authorize the use of school facilities for nonprofit or profit-making educational enterprises consistent with school goals;
4. Proper application is made to the administrative team who will process the request;
5. The user will reimburse the district for any damages done to the facilities and the custodial expense accrued to the district for setting up the facility for use; and
6. Eating and drinking in district facilities by permission only and at the discretion of the superintendent.

Uses of school facilities by tutors will be allowed provided:

1. The superintendent approves;
2. The tutoring takes place outside of regular school hours unless the superintendent approves otherwise;
3. Adequate space is available for the tutoring; and
4. The parents or guardians of the student pay all associated fees, including facilities use cost.
