Staff Liability

No employee of the district shall be held personally liable for the death or injury of any student resulting from participation in any classroom or extracurricular activity to which that student has been legally and properly assigned as a student in the school unless negligence on the part of the employee is a proximate cause of the death or injury.

Supervision of students is a primary teacher responsibility. Students shall not be left unattended or unsupervised at any time during regular classroom hours except in emergencies. Teachers shall exert their influence vigorously to prevent students from engaging in unsafe activities, to prevent boisterous and rude behavior and to prevent damage or injury to other persons and property.

Teachers shall immediately report to the building principal any and all unsafe conditions observed in or about school facilities.

No teacher shall grant permission for a student to leave the school building during regular school hours. Such permission can only be granted by the principal or his/her representative.

Teachers shall not send students on errands which would require the student to leave the school premises or which relate to the personal affairs of the teacher.

Field trips or excursions with students shall not be planned and executed until approved by the building principal.

Teachers shall not furnish any lists of names, addresses or phone numbers of students or teachers to anyone other than district administrators.

Teachers shall permit no advertisement to be read or distributed to students on school premises and shall not permit solicitation of students by salesmen or agents at any time that students are under the control of the school except as approved by the building principal.
