

Traffic Safety Education

The following procedures shall be used in implementing the district's traffic safety education program.

Tuition Rate

Each year prior to the Board's July organization meeting, the superintendent will provide the Board with data regarding the district's traffic safety education program. The data shall include the number of available "slots," the number of "slots" filled, the number of resident and nonresident students enrolled, the cost of the program, the amount of state reimbursement and other appropriate information. From this data, the superintendent will propose a tuition rate for Board adoption annually.

Reduction or Waived Tuition

When a student requests a waiver or reduction of the established fee for traffic safety education, a review committee consisting of the traffic safety education instructor, the student's counselor and a building administrator shall review the request.

The committee shall only consider students who qualify for free or reduced-price meals under the federal lunch program or students whose family believes the tuition is a severe hardship.

Tuition waivers or reductions may result in:

1. Accessing a fund set aside to assist needy students;
2. Setting up a work program with the student;
3. Setting up a "payment plan";
4. Other.
