Early Graduation**

A student who wishes to graduate from high school in less time than the ordinary grade 9-12 sequence may request permission to complete graduation requirements on an altered schedule. The student and his/her parents will consult with high school guidance personnel to develop a graduation plan which contains all elements of policy IKFA-AR. Their intention to accomplish this plan will be stated in writing to the building administration and approved by the Superintendent.

In order for an early graduation student to participate in SHS Graduation ceremonies, the student must demonstrate and meet two criteria:

1. Demonstrate good citizenship, not be a disruption to the educational process.
2. Have in place a Graduation plan consisting of:
 - a. Proof of a grade point average above 2.50;
 - b. Proof of successful completion of diploma standards;
 - c. Statement of educational, vocational, or employment plans;
 - d. Signed consent of parent/guardian for non-homeless student under the age of 18.

A student may satisfy graduation requirements in less than four years. The district will award a diploma to a student fulfilling graduation requirements in less than four years upon the student's request and if the student's parent or guardian consents, if required.

Students who have successfully completed the junior year with fewer than the required credits for graduation and are then accepted at accredited colleges may receive their high school diplomas if, at the completion of the first semester, they have successfully fulfilled the district's minimum diploma requirements.
