

Admission of Exchange Students

The district will accept a maximum of three students from other nations in those exchange programs officially recognized by the Board. The students may be enrolled in any of the high school programs.

Exchange programs recognized by the Board are those that have sending and hosting programs.

No other organizations/individual family placements will be allowed tuition waivers. Participation in non-approved programs will be on a tuition basis.

No student will be enrolled until all standards for admission have been cleared. Information such as the student's name, nationality, age, sponsor's name and address and immunization information will be required at the time of application.

Admission of exchange students can be made at the beginning of the second semester based on available enrollment according to policy. Applications for the start of the school year must be submitted by June 1. Selection will occur before June 15. All arrangements for admission in the fall semester must be concluded by August 1, prior to the beginning of the school term. All placement arrangements for admission to the second semester must be completed by December 1. No placements will be made after the semester begins.

Exchange students must agree to abide by district policies and regulations and those of the school they are attending.

At the time of admission to the public schools, the exchange student must be at least 16 years old but not older than 19 years of age.

If possible, organizations should avoid the placement of more than one student of a particular nationality in the same high school.

Exchange students are encouraged to assist in some manner the curriculum of the school they are attending, i.e., assist with language classes, history classes, etc.
