Interscholastic Activities Agreement (Students)

This agreement is made between [Print Student's Name] and the [District's Name]

Code of Conduct

I understand that participation in interscholastic activities is a privilege afforded me by the school. Thus, I promise to comply with the code of conduct listed in Board policy EGB - Code of Conduct for Interscholastic Activities. I will follow Oregon School Activities Association (OSAA) rules. I will demonstrate good sportsmanship. I will compete in a fair manner, and refrain from the use or abuse of controlled substances, alcohol and prohibited performance-enhancing drugs and supplements.

I understand that my violation of the terms of this policy and agreement may result in OSAA fining the district. In the event the district is fined by OSAA for my actions that are in violation of the terms of this policy and agreement, I agree to reimburse the district for any monetary penalty imposed by OSAA.

I understand that violation of these terms may result in discipline, including [revocation of the privilege to represent the school and participate in school-sponsored activities, events, clubs or programs for up to two school years and/or suspension, expulsion, or referral to law enforcement. School-conferred privileges, honors and distinctions may also be revoked.

I also understand that rehabilitation or counseling may be required by the district as a condition to further participation in district-sponsored activities, clubs or programs.

I Understand That I Must Follow

The eligibility criteria and team membership policy, which regulates participation in interscholastic competition at Scio High School. Please read this document and sign the accompanying statement of understanding. Both the athlete and parent/guardian must sign before the athlete may participate in interscholastic athletics.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in interscholastic competition in the district, a student must:

1. Pass all of the classes they are enrolled in and maintain a minimum GPA of 1.75.
2. Observe and abide by district rules and policies governing athletics and general student behavior.
3. Complete and submit all required medical and informational forms.

4. Must be in attendance on that school day for all classes in which they are enrolled. Student/Athletes will only be allowed to participate in activities (practice/games/contents/ with a pre-arranged absence.
5. OSAA requires an athlete to be enrolled as a full time student to participate in interscholastic athletics.
6. Under OSAA rules a student who fails two or more classes will be ineligible to participate for one semester.

Policy Concerning Team Membership

You team membership may be suspended for violation of the following general rules:

1. Use of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, drugs or controlled substances at any time during your participation in sports (including non school hours) is prohibited.
2. Hosting or attending a social function for minors where the above products are in possession, being used, sold or distributed, is prohibited.
3. Missing a practice or games unless (a) you have an excuse from school, or (b) you contact one of the coaches in your activity prior to practice or game, is prohibited.
4. Exceeding normal standard of conduct during travel, practice, or contests is expected.
 - a. You are a representative of your family, school, team and community.
 - b. You should expect no special treatment because you are an athlete.
 - c. You are expected to be on your best conduct going to, during and coming from an athletic contest.
 - (1) You will never argue with a game official.
 - (2) You will never carry on banter with the opposing team, or any spectators.
 - (3) You will never intentionally attempt to injure an opposing player.
 - (d) Your language and behavior should be such that it will never be a discredit to the team. Profanity, bickering, squabbling, and un-sportsman-like displays will not be tolerated at games or practices.
5. Failing to meet academic standards as stated above.
6. Failure to meet the criteria of the OSAA ejection policy.

Violating any of the preceding rules will be penalized in one or a combination of the four following manners:

1. Probation: athlete will be formally warned about his violation of a team regulation and likely will be dismissed from the team if any further violations occur.

2. Suspension: Will carry the name penalty as probation, plus the athlete will not be allowed to participate in specified number of official contests.
3. Dismissal: Athlete will be dismissed from the squad an athlete may be dismissed without any record of previous violation(s)
4. Denial of wards: any athlete who does not complete a season in good standing may be denied the opportunity to receive a letter, team awards, conference of state recognition.

Serious and repeated violations will be reviewed and penalties determined by the Athletic Board (consisting of the principal, the athletic director, and all Scio High School head coaches.)

The athlete will have an opportunity to present his/her case to the Athletic Board before a final determination of penalty is made.

Administrative Actions

The school administration may, for disciplinary purposes, declare a student to be ineligible for participation in extracurricular activities. Such actions are outside the scope and responsibilities of the athletic department, and must be appealed directly to the building principal.

Questions concerning an athlete’s participation in a sport, or in specific contest during the season, should be directed to the head coach or the athletic director. Any unresolved questions which may remain after contacting the coach and athletic director should be referred to the principal.
