Student Discipline

The Board will provide for “due process” in the management of students while attending district-sponsored activities or on district properties.

The major objectives of the district discipline program are to teach the following fundamental concepts for living:

1. Students shall comply with the written rules and regulations of the district;
2. Students will pursue the prescribed course of study;
3. Students will submit to the lawful authority of teachers and school officials;
4. Students will conduct themselves in an orderly fashion;
5. The district will provide an environment in which the safety of students and staff is paramount;
6. The district will create a climate that is conducive to learning, responsible self-discipline and considerate behavior.

A student whose conduct or condition is seriously detrimental to the school’s best interests may be suspended or expelled in accordance with administrative procedures and rules established by the superintendent. Such rules and procedures will ensure careful consideration of the rights and needs of the individual concerned, as well as the best interests of other students and the school program as a whole.
