## District Safety Program

The district safety program is a set of written guidelines designed to protect the students and employees of the district. All district employees shall be schooled in these guidelines, particularly those relating directly to their particular job. In addition, all district employees should be constantly on the alert for potential health and safety issues and report to the appropriate personnel all concerns.

Each building staff shall carry out periodic health and safety inspections of all buildings, grounds, vehicles, and equipment. The building principal is responsible to see that health and safety checks are conducted every three months.
