First Aid**

In case of sudden illness or injury to a student or a staff member, first aid will be given by school staff. Further medical attention to students is the responsibility of the parents or of someone the parents designate in case of emergency.

Each principal is charged with providing for the immediate care of ill or injured persons within his/her area of control.

In each school, procedures for handling health emergencies will be established and made known to the staff. Each school and school vehicle will be equipped with appropriate first-aid equipment.

All employees are expected to know where first-aid supplies and equipment are kept in their work areas. In accordance with state law, the district may require any staff member to hold a current, recognized first aid card. Designated employees in each building shall hold current first-aid cards. At least one teacher per grade level (K-8) is to maintain current first-aid/CPR cards in elementary schools with enrollments over 300 students. Except for the designated positions and grade level standard, the holding of first-aid/CPR cards shall not be a condition of employment, unless either the required ratio of one staff member to 60 students or an emergency response team is not maintained in a school.
