In an effort to promote effective learning, the administration recognizes the following:

1. Teacher-student ratio of each class;
2. Total number of students assigned to each teacher;
3. Number of subject preparations per teacher;
4. Support staff available to each teacher;
5. Nature of subjects taught in relation to each teacher's professional preparation;
6. Appropriateness of facilities and equipment;
7. Course goals applicable to the particular class;
8. Extent to which class size varies significantly from general statewide practice;
9. Age, maturity and ability of students;
10. The effectiveness of instruction based upon learning outcomes.
