

Guidelines for Selecting Drama Productions for Silverton High School

The high school principal and drama teacher will select plays based on the following criteria:

1. Suitability for high school students;
2. Appropriateness for the Silverton area community;
3. Literary and artistic merits;
4. Numbers of students who can participate and benefit from the production; and
5. Skills, talents and interests of drama students.

Once a play is selected for production, the following must occur:

1. Copies of the actual script, including edits, will be available for parents and students to review prior to tryouts.
2. A parent who objects to the content of the play and who decides to withhold permission for their student to participate in the play, is asked to inform the drama teacher and the school principal of their decision. If the parent requests a meeting with the drama teacher and principal, a meeting will be held in a timely manner.
