

## Assessment Exemption/Modification

The district believes the annual assessment of student and district progress is a vital component of the instructional process. While it is the district's intention to include every student in the district's and State's assessment programs, it is recognized that a few students may need to be exempted from the assessments because of unique educational, physical or emotional backgrounds.

Decisions regarding exemption of students from testing or modifications of test material, answer sheets, setting or administration are to be made annually on an individual basis as described in administrative regulations developed by the superintendent.
