

Elimination of Drugs and Alcohol on School Premises

The district shall publish expectations and develop procedures that eliminate the use of drugs and alcohol on district premises.

Each year the schools shall include in their student/parent handbooks, clear statements of expectations and consequences should a student use drugs or alcohol on school premises. Students and parents shall be informed that unlawful delivery of a controlled substance to a student or minor within 1,000 feet of school property is a Class A felony. Punishment is a maximum of 20 years of imprisonment, \$100,000 fine, or both.

The district shall record incidences, and annually review and report the findings to the Board.
