## Student Transportation Services

School transportation services will be provided for students to and from school and for transporting students to and from district sponsored activities including curricular and extracurricular activities. Transportation will be provided for homeless students to and from the student's school of origin<sup>1</sup> as required by the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLBA). These services shall be provided throughout the regularly scheduled year and during the regular school day as determined by the superintendent.

Elementary students grades K-6 who live more than one mile from school will be transported. Secondary students grades 7-12 who live more than one and one-half miles from school will be transported. Mileage exceptions for health, safety or disability will be made in accordance with the district's approved supplemental plan.
