Traffic Safety Education

The following procedures shall be used in implementing the district's traffic safety program.

Tuition Rate

Each year prior to the regular March Board meeting, the superintendent will provide the Board with data regarding the district's traffic safety education program. The data shall include expected enrollment, the cost of the program, amount of state reimbursement, and other information appropriate for determining the tuition rate, if any. The tuition rate, if necessary, will be adopted prior to the regular March Board meeting.

Non resident students will be allowed in the district traffic safety education program on a tuition fee basis after resident student enrollment is established and there are room and resources available.

All students shall be subject to the district code of conduct, policies, and regulations. Violation may result in disciplinary action up to and including denial in the traffic safety education program.

If there is a tuition fee, families who believe the tuition fee is a severe hardship, may set up a "payment plan" with the high school principal and bookkeeper. Each situation will be looked at on a case-by-case basis and a determination will be made by the principal.
