Talented and Gifted Program

The Board recognizes that learning takes place when the student is actively and enthusiastically engaged in striving toward meaningful goals. Methods of instruction must be based upon the educational objectives of the learning situation and must have relevance to the nature of the learner. Students and the public, at large, benefit when the staff recognizes and accommodates individual differences. If a student possesses outstanding gifts or talents, benefits to society may be maximized when such individual attributes are enhanced and developed.

A written plan that identifies programs or services needed to address the assessed levels of learning and accelerated rates of learning of identified students shall be similarly developed.

The Board is committed to an educational program that recognizes, identifies and serves the unique needs of talented and gifted students. Administrative procedures for identifying and serving the academically talented and intellectually gifted students K-12 shall be maintained.
