District Athletic Eligibility

Athletic practice sessions will be limited to two hours for high school and 90 minutes for elementary school and middle school teams during days when school is in session. Extra practice time on non-school days will be arranged with the athletic director.

No optional practices.

No practice will be held on Sundays.

No practice on the day before Thanksgiving or Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve or New Year's Day.

Practice held on other holidays may be held with permission of athletic director. Practice on any holiday must be between 8 am to 10 am or 5 pm to 7 pm.

The overall philosophy of athletic contact time is to use common sense, what is best for students, and communication with parents.

Coaches will be responsible to see that all equipment is put away and buildings locked up. Locking up after practice is not to be delegated to a student manager. Students must be supervised until they leave the school campus.
