Class Size

Prior to the enrollment of students for the school year the administration shall review the following factors to establish the number of students to be enrolled in each class:

1. Enrollment numbers - both current and projected;
2. Facility limitations;
3. Staff limitations;
4. Budget limitations;
5. Curriculum content;
6. Instructional method;
7. Needs of students;
8. Expected learning outcomes.

Maximum recommended class sizes are as follows:

Kindergarten- grade 3	25 Students
Physical education classes	40 Students
Music Classes	40 Students
Home economics classes	20 Students
Professional technical classes	20 Students
Special education classes	7 Students
All other classes grades 4-12	30 Students
Class sizes for special reading classes shall be established in accordance with E.S.E.A. Title 1 guidelines.	

At any time the actual or projected enrollment in a class exceeds the recommended maximum, this information shall be reported by the principal to the Board along with recommendations for reduction of class size.
