Instructional Resources/Instructional Materials

The Board believes that proper care and judgment should be exercised in selecting basic instructional materials for student use. While the Board retains the authority to approve district instructional materials adoptions, it authorizes the superintendent to develop and implement administrative procedures governing how selections are determined.

Such procedures will provide for staff, parent and community involvement through such means as building site councils and employ suitable selection criteria to ensure that the recommended instructional materials:

1. Display fairness in their portrayal of people;
2. Contain appropriate readability levels;
3. Show consistency with the district's adopted curriculum content;
4. Provide for ease of teacher use;
5. Are attractive and durable;
6. Can be purchased at reasonable cost.
7. Do not discriminate on the basis of race, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, age, disability or marital status.
