## Class Rankings

In the interest of encouraging and recognizing outstanding academic achievement, a valedictorian and a salutatorian will be selected for each graduating class. The valedictorian and salutatorian will be selected according to the following procedure:

1. The valedictorian will be the student with the highest grade point average as computed at the end of seven semesters of high school work;
2. The salutatorian will be the student with the second highest grade point average as computed at the end of seven semesters of high school work;
3. Students must have taken all of the required classes for their graduating class plus the following classes (or commensurate level thereof);
  - a. Mathematics: Two years of math, one of which must be geometry or algebra II;
  - b. Science: Two years of science, one of which must be chemistry or physics or biology II;
  - c. Foreign language, fine arts, applied arts or vocational arts: two years in the same area (e.g, Spanish I and II, band, home economics, etc.);
  - d. Language arts: One year of college prep English.
4. In the event one or no students meet the above, then the valedictorian and/or salutatorian will be chosen strictly by GPA.
5. To be eligible for valedictorian or salutatorian honors, a student must be enrolled and attending at Stanfield High School two semesters preceding graduation.
