Intradistrict Transfer Students

With the superintendent's approval, the district may grant the request of a resident student to attend another high school, provided the receiving school agrees to that request.

Students who attend a district school identified under the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 for improvement, corrective action or restructuring may, as required by law, transfer to another public school in the district which has not been identified for improvement or as persistently dangerous. Building capacity will not be used as a determining factor in transfer decisions. Priority will be given to the lowest achieving students from low income families, as required by law. Additionally, students who attend a district school identified as persistently dangerous, or who are victims of a violent criminal offense occurring in or on the grounds of the school the student attends, may transfer to a safe public school in the district that has not been identified as in need of improvement.

The district will provide transportation to these students.
