Alcohol**

Students in violation of the district's alcohol policy will be subject to the following disciplinary action:

1. **First Offense:** Any student who violates the district's alcohol policy as a first offense may be suspended from school for five school days. A conference with the parents or guardian and a chemical dependency evaluation will be required before the student will be readmitted to school.
2. **Second Offense:** Any student who violates this policy a second time may be suspended from school for five school days and also have a hearing scheduled for his/her expulsion from school. If the hearings officer, on the basis of evidence presented, rules the student is to be expelled, then he/she will recommend so to the Board. The expulsion will be for the rest of the semester. If the expulsion takes place within the last three weeks of a semester, then it will carry over and include the following semester.

Substance Abuse**

Students in violation of the district's substance/drug abuse policy will be subject to the following disciplinary actions:

Possession/Use:

1. Students in violation of the district's substance/drug abuse policy for the first time may be immediately suspended from school for five school days for possession and/or use of narcotics, dangerous drugs or controlled substances on district grounds or at district functions. A chemical dependency evaluation and conference with the parents or guardian will be required before the student will be readmitted to school.
2. Any student who violates this policy a second time may be immediately suspended from school for five school days and also have a hearing scheduled for his/her expulsion from school. If the hearings officer, on the basis of evidence presented, rules the student is to be expelled then he/she will recommend so to the Board. The expulsion will be for the rest of the semester. If the expulsion takes place within the last three weeks of a semester, then it will carry over and include the following semester.

Sale and Supply

1. Students found to be in violation of this policy by selling or supplying narcotics or habit forming drugs may be immediately suspended from school and a recommendation made to the Board for his/her expulsion for the remainder of the semester.

Students feinting the selling, supplying, using or under the influence of narcotics or habit forming drugs will be subject to disciplinary action commensurate with the seriousness of the act.

Drug violations by students either in possession, use or sale will be reported to proper law enforcement officials for subsequent follow-up action on their part.

Use of drug authorized by medical prescription from a registered physician shall not be considered a violation of this rule.
