## **Funding Proposals and Applications**

The Board has as its primary mission the education of district students according to adopted goals and objectives. To this end all legal and worthwhile financial resources, especially those that will alleviate the local tax burden, will be pursued.

Grants-in-aid may become available from either the federal or state government. The district will pursue those grants that will assist the district in meeting the adopted goals and objectives of the current curriculum or will create facilities, purchase equipment or otherwise assist in implementing such programs as the Board approves.

Grant proposals for external funds from private sources will be submitted to the Board for evaluation and approval.

In the event an opportunity arises to submit a grant proposal and there is insufficient time to place it before the Board, the superintendent is authorized to use his/her judgment in approving it for submission. The superintendent will review the grant proposal with the Board at its next regular meeting. The Board reserves the right to reject funds associated with any grant which has been approved.

The Board directs that each presentation regarding the pursuit of outside funding include the obligations, expectations or encumbrances which will exist when the grant or other outside funding ceases.

The Board will tend to look with favor upon such requests for grants that meet the criteria above, have the recommendations of the superintendent, and are explained fully before the grant is requested. The Board reaffirms its veto power over all grants before actual acceptance.
