Title I/Parental Involvement

The Board recognizes that parent involvement is vital to achieve maximum educational growth for students participating in the district's programs. Therefore, in compliance with federal law and Oregon Department of Education guidelines, these programs will be planned and operated in meaningful consultation with parents of participating children including outreach to parents who are economically disadvantaged, are disabled, have limited English proficiency, have limited literacy, are migratory, or are of any racial, cultural or ethnic minority background. Information and school reports will be provided in an understandable and uniform format and, to the extent practicable, in a language parents can understand.

The Board particularly directs the superintendent to ensure that each of the district's schools participating in the Title I or Title III programs meet at least annually; that parents of all students shall be informed of their right to be involved in the development of the district's Parent Involvement policy, overall Title I plan and school-parent compacts; and that all parents shall be provided with meaningful opportunities to engage in their child's schooling with clear indications of procedures for providing for such opportunities.

The Board also directs the superintendent to ensure procedures as necessary to implement this policy and meet the requirements of law will be maintained in either handbook form and/or accessible electronically in all of the district's schools, and ensure that technical assistance is provided to schools to foster implementation of these procedures.

The superintendent shall develop administrative regulations, as necessary, to implement this policy and meet the requirements of law.
