

Early Graduation

A student who wishes to graduate from high school in less time than the ordinary grade 9-12 sequence may request permission to complete graduation requirements on an altered schedule. The student and his/her parents will consult with high school guidance personnel to develop a graduation plan. Their intention to accomplish this plan will be stated in writing to the building principal. The graduation plan will include:

1. Application;
2. Agreement for no class ranking;
3. Application to participate in graduation exercises;
4. Completed Expanded Options program, as outlined by the building principal.

A student may satisfy graduation requirements in less than four years. The district will award a diploma to a student fulfilling graduation requirements in less than four years upon the student's request and if the student's parent or guardian consents, if required.
