Safety Committee

It is the policy of the district to protect the safety and health of students and employees from needless and preventable injuries and property loss. The district has established a safety and health program adapted to fundamental safety concepts that will help to prevent injury and loss due to recognized hazards.

Management

It is the superintendent's responsibility to provide direction and support of safety procedures, job training and hazard elimination practices. He/She shall establish and support each building's safety committee whose responsibility it is to identify hazards, make corrective suggestions, identify employee and student safety training needs and investigate accidents and injuries.

Committee

There shall be four members on each building safety committee. The committee shall consist of one administrator and three members of the classified and licensed units (for a total of four), with each unit being represented by at least one member.

Terms shall be for three years. The committee shall meet once per month. There shall be quarterly safety inspections made by the committee. Records of safety inspections shall be forwarded to the district safety officer.
