

## Emergency Procedures and Disaster Plans

The superintendent will develop and maintain a plan specifying procedures to be used in such emergencies as disorderly behavior, unlawful assembly, disturbances at district activities, natural disasters, fire, illness or injury of a student or staff member and use of force on district property. The superintendent will consult with community and county agencies while developing this plan.

The emergency procedures plan of the district will meet or exceed the minimum standards of the State Board of Education.

Copies of the emergency procedures plan will be available in the district office. Copies of the Emergency Procedures Plan will be available in every school office and other strategic location throughout the district. Parents will be informed of the district's plan for the care of students during an emergency situation.
