Buildings and Grounds Maintenance

Safety and economy of operation require effective maintenance of the district's physical facilities. Building principals are charged with the responsibility of caring for and protecting their facilities. Building principals shall systematically inspect all buildings, equipment, playgrounds and playground apparatus to ensure adequate maintenance. Dangerous or unsafe conditions shall be remedied as soon as possible.

Teachers shall be responsible for the safe use of buildings, grounds and equipment in the classrooms and other areas in which they teach. Employees shall report promptly to the principal any defects in building, furniture, playground apparatus or other equipment that may prove injurious to the comfort, health or safety of students.
