## Classified Staff/Classified Staff Positions

Classified personnel are those employees in job positions for which no teaching, personal services or administrative licenses are required by law nor whose position has been designated as supervisory or confidential. The district shall hire classified employees who will attend to their duties and the welfare of students.

Regular classified employees are those employed in positions established by the Board.

The essential job functions, and titles and examples of work performed, are to be prescribed in a written job description for each position classification.
