Philosophy

It is the responsibility of the district to educate students to be members actively contributing to the preservation and improvement of the American democracy.

The district also has a shared responsibility with the home, the church and the community in the development and reinforcement of moral and ethical standards.

The educational program of the district should be designed for the development of the individual according to his/her own potentials and needs.

Methods of instruction should provide students the opportunity for active participation in the learning process.

The organization of the district should provide an atmosphere conducive to mutual respect for the rights and responsibilities of others.

The teacher should use his/her experience and knowledge to guide and give direction to the education of each student.

Education is both a privilege and a right for every student.

Student promotion should be based upon his/her achievement in relation to his/her ability.

The district may provide for the adult educational needs of the community as deemed appropriate.
