

Prevention Education Programs for Drugs and Alcohol

The district is utilizing "Here's Looking At You 2000" in developing our age-appropriate alcohol prevention program.

Our program is comprised of the following:

"Here's Looking At You 2000," our drug and alcohol prevention program which is the result of consultation with parents, teachers, administration, community agencies and our school nurse. The program includes a three-day staff development training program developed by a local trainer. The trainer reviews the curriculum and relates the district's plan and responsibilities within the plan for prevention.

Instruction shall include:

1. Emphasis on intervention;
2. Effects of alcohol, tobacco and other drug use;
3. All laws for minors relating to use;
4. Availability of community resources;
5. Understanding/managing peer pressure;
6. Consequences of consumption of alcohol and drugs;
7. Decision making;
8. Motivation for students to adopt positive attitudes toward health/wellness.
