Volunteers

Citizens who voluntarily contribute their time, energy, and talents to the improvement and enrichment of the public schools instructional and other programs are valuable assets. The Board encourages constructive participation of groups and individuals in the school or on school grounds, whether leased or owned, to perform appropriate tasks before, during, and after school hours under the direction and supervision of professional school personnel. Every effort should be made to use volunteer resources in a manner, which will ensure maximum contribution to the welfare and educational growth of students.

The administration is responsible for the recruitment, use, coordination and training of volunteers. These assignments will be carried out as directed or delegated by the superintendent. Volunteers shall be subject to a criminal history records check conducted by the Oregon Department of Education.

Any person who has committed a crime as set forth in ORS 342.143 and 342.175 that would result in a suspension of license if they were a teacher shall disqualify such person as a volunteer.

The acceptance and utilization of the service of any person on a voluntary basis shall be at the discretion of the district.
