

School Attendance Areas

Attendance areas are established by the administration and approved by the Board for all school buildings in the district. Boundaries are set for attendance areas so that students can be given the best possible education at the lowest possible cost.

Defined attendance areas reduce overcrowding and promote efficient use of space and personnel. The superintendent is directed to monitor attendance at each school and to make adjustments as needed. All changes in school attendance areas should benefit the total school program educationally and financially.

Students may be allowed to attend a school outside of their designated attendance area, subject to the approval of the principal. The district shall not be responsible for student transportation outside of the designated attendance area, unless required by state or federal laws.
