

Naming New Facilities

“Name Our School” Contest - Rules and Criteria

1. Any resident of the district is eligible to submit a name for a new school. The contest is open to adults and students. Members of the Board and members of the name selection committee (see #9) are not eligible to submit names.
2. Individuals may enter as many names as they wish, but each name should be on a separate entry form.
3. Entry forms will be available in the main office at any Sherwood schools. They will also be available at the district office. Entry forms may be copied.
4. Entries can be deposited in special “Name Our New School” contest boxes at each school or mailed to:
5. Entries must be deposited or postmarked by: _____. Entries received after that date will not be considered.
6. Entries must be in good taste.
7. Entries that contain the name of a living person will not be accepted.
8. Names that include an apostrophe should be avoided.
9. A name selection committee, appointed by the Board, will consider each entry. The committee will submit up to three choices for school names to the Board at the Board’s next most appropriate meeting.
10. School name entrants whose contest name(s) are submitted to the Board as finalists will be invited to present their name to the Board.
11. The Board will make the final decision in naming the new school.
