

Private Tutoring for Pay

It is the policy of the Board that teachers are not to tutor for remuneration any students whom they currently have in class. No tutoring for which a teacher receives a fee will be allowed in a school building or on school time.

Exceptions to this policy are as follows:

1. Private lessons, such as music lessons and other enrichment activities, which are clearly beyond the scope of the regular curriculum, may be given for remuneration outside of school time and away from school buildings;
2. Teachers may tutor students, eligible for home-bound services, for remuneration outside of normal school hours.
