## Cocurricular/Extracurricular Activities

Students in the district must meet the following conditions to participate in identified extracurricular activities that are not part of a designed class. These activities include all athletic groups, drama (all school performances), rally, dance and drill, speech, and associated student body offices.

In order for students to participate, they must do the following:

1. Maintain a minimum grade point average of a 2.0.
2. If a student's GPA is below a 2.0 and no more than one failing grade, he/she will attend a prescribed study hall outside the normal work day
3. Any student who had two or more Fs is ineligible to participate. Progress report grades will be used for determining eligibility during the Trimester.
4. Progress report grades will be used for determining eligibility during the trimester with final trimester grades used at the end of the trimester.
