School Attendance Areas

The planning and establishing of attendance area boundaries shall be the responsibility of the Board.

The following criteria shall serve as a guide to administrative planning and in the establishment of attendance areas.

Whenever possible, neighborhood areas, particularly at the elementary level, should be retained within a single attendance boundary. A decision to change or establish new attendance area boundaries shall take into consideration the following factors: proximity to the school, safety, transportation costs, availability of space and student body composition and staffing patterns of the schools involved.

The efficient and economical utilization of the schools, consistent with the general educational program and plan of the district and the need to house both students and support services, shall be considered.

The attendance plan as developed by the superintendent shall provide for a committee process of district staff, parents and students if appropriate to make recommendations as to the actual attendance area plan.

Residents of areas proposed to be moved when boundaries are to be changed shall be given an opportunity to respond to the proposed changes prior to implementation.
