

Participation in Foreign Exchange Program

The district advocates Sherwood students participating in foreign exchange and foreign study programs.

Students who intend to participate in a foreign exchange or a foreign study program need to initiate preplanning through the counseling office to ensure timely graduation from Sherwood High School, unless they are attending one of the following:

1. A U.S. military installation; or
2. An American school for U.S. dependents in foreign countries.

Seeking credit, a student must have transcripts evaluated by a committee composed of high school principal, counselor and superintendent or designee and/or an independent transcript evaluating service. Credit will be issued based upon the transcript evaluation.

The district assumes no financial responsibility for students who are participating in a foreign exchange or a foreign study program. Procurement and processing of all transcripts and legal documents needed for international travel and study are the financial responsibility of the student.
