

Intradistrict Transfer Students

With the superintendent's approval, the district may grant the request of a resident student to attend another school, provided the receiving school agrees to that request.

Students who attend a district school identified as persistently dangerous, or who are victims of a violent criminal offense occurring in or on the grounds of the school the student attends, may transfer to a safe public school in the district, including transfer to a public charter school.

The superintendent will develop administrative regulations, as necessary, to implement this policy.
