

Student Dress and Grooming**

Responsibility for dress and grooming rests primarily with students and their parents; however, the district expects student dress and grooming to meet standards which insure that the following conditions do not exist:

1. Disruption or interference with the classroom learning environment;
2. Threats to health and/or safety of the student concerned or of other students;
3. Clothing decorated or marked with illustrations, words or phrases which are vulgar, obscene or promote behavior which violates school conduct standards, or exhibits youth gang-related symbols, colors or insignias is not permitted;
4. Any display or signal for the purpose of identifying youth gang membership or youth gang support.

Students who represent the school in a voluntary activity may be required to conform to dress and grooming standards approved by the superintendent and may be denied the opportunity to participate if those standards are not met.
