## **Expulsion\*\***

Only the superintendent or designee and/or the Board has the authority to expel a student according to the provisions of regulations approved by the Board.

The superintendent will give the student and parent/guardian/custodian written notice of the intended expulsion, giving reasons for the intended expulsion. Such notice will state the time and place for a hearing with the superintendent not less than three school days nor more than seven school days from the date of the notice.

Present at the hearing will be the student and parent/guardian/custodian. If the student is represented by an attorney, the school district's attorney may be present, as well. Parent and student may waive this hearing.

If as a result of the hearing the superintendent decides to expel the student, the superintendent will so notify the parent and the Board. The notice must include the reasons for expulsion, the right of appeal to the Board, the right to be represented at the appeal, and the right to request the hearing to be held in executive session.
