

Private Tutoring for Pay

Teachers will not tutor for remuneration any students whom they have in class. No tutoring for which a teacher receives a fee will be allowed in a school building or on school time, unless specifically requested to do so by the principal and/or parents, and no district-owned materials or equipment may be used.

Exceptions to this policy are as follows:

1. Private lessons, such as music lessons and other enrichment activities, which are clearly beyond the scope of the regular curriculum, may be given for remuneration outside of school time and away from school buildings;
2. Teachers may tutor for remuneration outside of normal school hours students eligible for home-bound services, according to procedures established by the superintendent;
3. District authorized and/or sponsored programs.
