Classified Staff

Classified personnel are those employees in positions for which no teaching or administrative licenses are required by law. The district shall hire classified employees who will attend to their duties and the welfare of students.

Regular classified employees are those employed in positions established by the Board requiring 20 or more hours per week for at least a full school year.

Lead employees are those who exercise some supervisory responsibility over other classified employees, as indicated on the job description.

The essential job functions, and titles and examples of work performed, are to be prescribed in a written job description for each position classification.
