Relations with Private Schools

The district recognizes that private schools offer a different alternative for parents and students than the public schools of the Siuslaw School District. The district respects and wishes to cooperate with these schools and will pursue the following guidelines in establishing and fostering that relationship.

The district will advertise annually services and programs that are available through federal funds and how arrangements can be made to use these services.

Students from private schools may enroll in individual courses at school with the same privileges and rights of those who attend district schools. Private school students who choose to enroll in a class or classes in the district are subject to the same rules and regulations as other students in attendance at these schools. Credits may be transferred in accordance with established administrative regulations.

Students who attend private schools are eligible to ride district transportation from home to school and participate in district or school extracurricular activities with principal approval and within the state guidelines.

The principal will approve the school's acceptance of home schooling credits toward graduation (See policy JECDA).
