**Emergency Procedures and Disaster Plans**

The superintendent will develop and maintain a plan specifying procedures to be used in such emergencies as disorderly behavior, unlawful assembly, disturbances at school activities, natural disasters, fire, illness or injury of a student or staff member and use of force on school property. The superintendent will consult with community and county agencies while developing this plan.

The district's Emergency Management Plan will meet or exceed the minimum standards of the State Board of Education.

Copies of the Emergency Management Plan will be available in every school office and other unit offices. Parents will be informed of the district's plan for the care of students during an emergency situation. The Board may use Oregon Revised Statute 192.660(2)(k) to go into an executive session to consider matters related to school safety or a plan that responds to safety threats made toward a school in the district.
