School Bus Scheduling and Routing

Actual bus stops and routes will be determined by the superintendent or designee in cooperation with the contractor and will be based upon efficiency, safety, Board policy and applicable state and federal laws and regulations.

The determination of safe roads for school bus travel will be made by the superintendent and contractor. School bus service will be limited to paved (black top or concrete), oiled or existing roads which are maintained by state, federal or county governments unless otherwise directed by Board action.

The superintendent and contractor will:

1. Annually review and assess school bus routes, stops and loading zones for safety, changing student population and supervision of students;
2. Advise parents of any change in transportation policy affecting their students as early as possible and be responsive to parents' calls of assistance in seeking alternatives to busing;
3. Work with cities, counties and other appropriate governmental agencies on a continuing basis to inform them of transportation issues, as appropriate.
