**Student Fund-Raising Activities**

All door to door fund raising by students must be approved by the superintendent and supervised by the appropriate advisor.

Fund-raising projects involving the sale of products must be approved by the activity sponsor and by the principal before the activity is initiated. Solicitation of funds is expressly prohibited without consent of the superintendent.

If fund raising consists of selling food and beverage items to students during the regular or extended school day, the food and beverage items must comply with state and federal nutrition standards, rules and laws. This does not apply to food and beverage items sold at school-related or nonschool-related events for which parents and other adults are a significant part of the audience.
