

Early/Delayed Graduation

Early Graduation

All credit requirements must be met by a specified date agreed upon by the student, parent, counselor and principal to qualify for early graduation. Requests for early graduation must be made on the appropriate form and submitted to the principal at least two weeks prior to the beginning of the semester in which the student plans to finish.

Delayed Graduation

Any student who has not reached 21 years of age prior to the beginning of the current school year and has not graduated from high school or is receiving special education services and has not received a regular high school diploma may attend for completion of graduation requirements. A planned program will be agreed upon by the student, counselor, parent and principal and will consist of a minimum of a four-period day. The plan may include work experience for part of the four periods. Regular attendance will also be part of the contract. A person completing a delayed graduation contract will receive a diploma or modified diploma, as appropriate, dated the year the contract is completed. Students who have previously received a GED and are not yet 21 years of age prior to the beginning of the current school year may return to high school to complete district graduation requirements for a high school diploma.
