Community Use of District Facilities

Community groups will be permitted and encouraged to use district facilities for worthwhile purposes when such uses will not interfere with district programs.

The responsibility of the Board in the area of community use of district facilities and areas is three-fold:

1. To make the facilities and areas of the district available to citizens in as many ways as possible;
2. To be accountable for prudent maintenance and fiscal management of these assets; and
3. To establish policies and procedures for use of buildings and grounds owned by the district.

It is the policy of the Board that district facilities and designated areas shall be made available, under capable and responsible supervision, for community activities of an educational, recreational, social, cultural or civic nature, so long as such use does not interfere with the school program.

To assure the district facilities and designated areas will best serve the public, the superintendent will develop administration regulations as needed governing the use, use priority and associated fees and conditions for acceptable use of district property.
